Available January 1, 2013

NEW DEADLINE: MAY 31, 2013

The Office of the State Superintendent of Education (OSSE) urges college-bound District of Columbia residents to submit their DC OneApp before the deadline of May 31, 2013.

The DC OneApp is the online application college-bound District residents use to apply for funding from the District of Columbia's Tuition Assistance Grant (DCTAG). DCTAG provides up to \$10,000 toward the difference between in-state and out-of-state tuition at public four-year colleges and universities throughout the US, Guam and Puerto Rico. DCTAG also provides up to \$2,500 per academic year toward tuition at private colleges and universities in the District and private Historically Black Colleges and Universities (HBCUs) and two-year colleges nationwide.

The DC OneApp is part of a three-step process that requires:

1. Completing the DC OneApp at <https://dconeapp.dc.gov>
2. Completing the FAFSA at <http://www.fafsa.ed.gov>
3. Providing the [DC OneApp required supporting documents](#) at the same time

All required supporting documents must be postmarked or hand-delivered before the May 31, 2013 deadline to avoid a Waiting List status. A Waiting List status reduces an applicant's chances of receiving DCTAG funding.
