- > 947 Felony Drug offense counts sentenced
- > 920 Felony Drug offense cases sentenced
- > 872 individuals sentenced for Felony Drug offenses

Almost half (49%) of the Drug counts sentenced in this timeframe were sentenced in 2018



## Drug Offenses in Superior Court\_

### **Overall Trends**


- Drug offenses made up approximately 14% of all 6,918 felony counts sentenced between 2018 and 2022
- **68%** of the Drug offenses sentenced between 2018 and 2022 were in offense severity group
  - ➤ Only 1 sentenced Drug count was in offense severity group D1
- 47% of the Drug convictions involved Cocaine, 20% involved PCP, 14% involved Heroin
- 45% of the Drug offenses were for Possession with Intent to Distribute a Controlled Substance



- Possession with Intent to Manufacture a Controlled Substance
- Possession with Intent to Distribute a Controlled Substance
- Possession with Intent to Distribute Marijuana
- Unlawful Possession of Liquid PCP
- Distribution of a Controlled Substance

## **Sentencing Trends**

- Over half (51%) of the Drug convictions resulted in a probation sentence
- For Drug convictions that resulted in a prison sentence, the average sentence imposed was 19 months; after accounting for time suspended, the average sentence to serve was 18 months
- 96% of the Drug counts were resolved via a plea agreement



#### **Offender Characteristics**

- 92% of the defendants were Male
- 97% of the defendants were Black
- The average age at offense was 37 years old; the median age at offense was 35 years old
